Shout out to a team at Latham & Watkins that got one of a number of proposed class actions pending against CCC Intelligent Solutions Inc., knocked out on a motion for judgment on the pleadings in the Middle District of Florida. This case, in particular, claimed that CCC systematically applied unexplained and unjustified condition adjustments when determining the value of wrecked cars deemed to be "total losses." But U.S. District Judge William Jung in Tampa this week found the plaintiff was not a third-party beneficiary of the service agreement between CCC and his insurer.
